



COMPANY ENVIRONMENT POLICY

The Company consider it has a duty to exercise due care and to take adequate measures so as to prevent the occurrence of pollution from ships and to reduce the effects of any pollution in order to protect the environment.

PRIORITY:

The Company will undertake all measures for the prevention of all kinds of pollution from the vessel under its management and for ensuring the observance of all international and local regulations.

LEGISLATION:

In that legislation will be constantly under review and will be amended and enhanced, the Company undertakes to keep abreast reviews and to implement any changes as necessary.

SHIPBOARD RESPONSIBILITY:

Pollution of the environment from a ship can be in many forms and all personnel are encouraged to reduce or eliminate pollution whenever possible. It is the duty of the individual as well as the Company to preserve the environment and all employees are expected to adopt a mature and positive attitude in this respect.

MASTER'S RESPONSIBILITY:

On board the ship the Master has the overall responsibility for ensuring the observance of pollution prevention measures and is to promote the Company's policy for the protection of the environment.

REVIEW - SHIPBOARD:

The Master is to review the onboard environmental protection procedures as and when necessary, but in particular when any form of discharge is to be performed that could result in damage to the environment.

The Master is to keep the Company fully informed of all cases where damage to the environment has occurred as soon as possible after the occurrence or was in danger of occurring, reporting fully on each incident and the measures taken or recommended for adoption, so as to prevent any future occurrence.

REVIEW - SHORE BASE:

The Company will review both the introduced and/or pending legislation in respect of environmental protection etc. as well as all reports and/or recommendations received from the ships in respect of environmental protection.

Based upon the conclusion of the reviews, the management will consider modifying existing procedures and/or the implementing of the procedures in line with the requirements of legislation.
